

Glamorgan Archery Association: *Giving back to the Clubs*



Improving the GAA Visibility

Glamorgan Archery Association will make available a one-off grant of not more than £150, for the purpose of supporting club promotional activity and improving the visibility of GAA within affiliated clubs. GAA will make this funding available to meet the cost of club promotional materials, such as flags, banners, posters, etc.... All material will need to carry the approved GAA logo in a visibly prominent position..

Eligibility criteria:-

- The one off grant is payable to any affiliated club within the GAA area

Conditions :-

- The grant is payable in arrears to assist with the cost of promotional materials carrying the GAA logo
- Promotional material will include such items as flags, banners, posters, advertising or promotional materials
- The GAA logo must be easily visible on all of the materials being purchased, however it is not required to be the largest feature in the design.
- The grant is not repayable.
- Payment to clubs will be in arrears and on receipt of a claim supported by the invoice confirming payment of the goods has been made by the club making the claim.
- Payment will be payable by GAA for the amount defrayed, up to and not exceeding £150.
- One claim per club only will be accepted . Multiple items may be purchased but need to all be claimed at the same time (e.g. 1 flag costing £150 or 3 banners costing £50 each are both valid claims)
- Final date for claims will be the end of September 2020
