## CLAIM FOR COUNTY RECORD SHOT BY A COUNTY ARCHER

### CRITERIA FOR NON-RECORD STATUS COMPETITIONS

Claims can only be made by fully paid up G.A.A. members

Claims for records in relation to Record Status competitions must follow the established guidelines for that competition, bow style and category of archer.

Claims for non-record status competitions need to comply with the following criteria for any claim to be successfully ratified.

The round shot must be a nationally recognised round.

The round must be shot to the accepted national criteria (distance, face size, number of arrows, etc).

There must be a Director of Shooting (not necessarily a formally qualified judge, although such would be preferable), who should be an experienced archer (that is an adult who has achieved an outdoor classification) and should not take part in the competition on the day. This Director would be responsible for the conduct of the tournament and the observation of all safety and round compliance rules.

The result sheet should be signed off, by the Director of Shooting, to the effect that the compliance with all rules was effected, and should be submitted, as normal, within 28 days of the completion of the tournament.

The competition itself **MUST** be planned in advance and should be minuted in the hosting club's official minutes. The proposed round, date and Director of Shooting should be recorded in these minutes. Any guests shooting with the club at hat tournament should be GNAS members for insurance purposes, as with any formal

N.B. A more mature archer may (subject to age qualification) claim for Vet . and Senior or Master and Senior if the Senior record has not previously been claimed **BUT** a Vet . may not claim a Master as well as Vet.
