### CRITERIA FOR CLAIMS

Claims can only be made by current G.A.A. members.

Claims for records in relation to Record Status competitions must follow ALL ArcheryGB guidelines for that competition, (distance, face size, number of arrows, etc).

Claims for non-record status competitions must comply with the following criteria to be successfully ratified.-

There must be a Director of Shooting (not necessarily a formally qualified judge, although such would be preferable), who should be an experienced archer (that is an adult who has achieved an outdoor classification) and should not take part in the competition on the day. This Director would be responsible for the conduct of the tournament and the observation of all safety and round compliance rules.

The round shot must be a nationally recognised round and follow ALL ArcheryGB guidelines for that competition (distance, face size, number of arrows, etc).

The competition itself MUST be planned in advance and all details should be recorded in the hosting club's official minutes. Any guests shooting with the club at that tournament should be ArcheryGB members for insurance purposes, as with any formal competition.
