Event Format	<p style="text-align: center;">There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details on Layered Foam Boses Compounds will shoot 60cm, 6 Scoring zones 3 spot Faces. All others will be using 60cm, 10 scoring zone Full Face. Shooting will be in timed 3 arrow ends. Scoring will be using 2 score sheets.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">We also reserve the possibility of using a lanseo phone App. instead of a second sheet. Please indicate on application form if you are prepared to use your phone to score using lanseo.</p>

<p>Individual Awards</p>	<p>Glamorgan Archers must indicate that they have joined Glamorgan, by paying the GAA Subscripsion fee. Through their Club or directly if a Direct AGB Member. This needs to be indicated on the application form with a G for Glamorgan or V for Visitor.</p> <p>Awards will be presented per gender, bowstyle and age group for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd if there are 3 Archers per group, for the single round ONLY. Only your first round will count.</p> <p>Preference will be given to Single Round only up until the Closing Date.</p> <p>Any Juniors will be shooting as Seniors. No Junior Awards will be awarded.</p> <p>Double rounds will only be allocated after this date at an additional cost of £10.00, if spaces are available.</p> <p>Please indicate if you wish to do this on application form as it will be on a first come first served basis .</p>
<p>Dress Code</p>	<p>Competitors must conform to AGB Rules of Shooting for dress regulations (Rule 307).</p> <p>Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentation.</p>
<p>Drug Testing</p>	<p>All archers competing in record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply, if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. By signing to enter the tournament parents/ legal guardians are giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.</p>
