<b>U12</b>	You can compete in the U12 category throughout the calendar year of your 11th birthday.
<b>U14</b>	You can compete in the U14 category throughout the calendar year of your 13th birthday.
<b>U16</b>	You can compete in the U16 category throughout the calendar year of your 15th birthday.
<b>U18</b>	You can compete in the U18 category throughout the calendar year of your 17th birthday.
<b>U21</b>	You can compete in the U21 category throughout the calendar year of your 20th birthday.

- U12, U14 and U16 archers can shoot in their age category or above if they wish.
- U18 and U21 archers can shoot at 50m or 70m.
